At Perryville, Kansas, on the 3rd inst., Mr. EABLE COOLEY, late of Arison, and for a number of years an active partner in the house of Arnold & Cooley, and subsequent, Arnold, Cooley & Co. Mr. C. was a native of Connecticut, and came to this place about 1848, and married a daughter of Mr. David Tillman, and by perseverance and close attention to business had gathered together a snug little fortune, which he lost in a measure by the fortunes of war, and subsequently by a fire on the 2d April, 1868, which swept away his store house and all its contents. He removed to Kansas, and was recuperating from his losses, and had he lived would no doubt have acquired a fortune. He was a man of great energy. He leaves a widow and several children to mourn their heavy loss—though not without hope, as we are informed he died in the full assurance of a better home in the skies.
